

ORDINANCE NO. 2-88A

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT THAT PORTION OF ALLEN STREET LYING BETWEEN BLOCKS 83 AND 84, MOORE'S ADDITION, CITY OF MOULTON, LAVACA COUNTY, TEXAS BE VACATED, ABANDONED AND CLOSED: PROVIDING FOR THE SALE OF SAID LAND: REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH: AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MOULTON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That that portion of Allen Street lying between Blocks 83 and 84, Moore's Addition, City of Moulton, Lavaca County, Texas be and the same is hereby closed, abandoned and permanently vacated as a street or public thoroughfare of any kind or character whatever.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor of the City of Moulton is hereby authorized and directed to convey by quitclaim deed all of the interest of the City of Moulton, Texas in and to the portion of Allen Street described in Section 1 of this ordinance pursuant to § 253.001 and § 272.001 of the local Government Code, Vernon's Annotated Texas Statute.

The City of Moulton, Texas shall reserve all of its right, title and interest in and to any utility lines or easements located in, on or under said property perpetually together with the rights of ingress and egress to repair, replace, remove, lay new lines or examine lines in place.

SECTION 3: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage, and it is so ordained.

SECTION 5: The importance of this ordinance creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the rule requiring ordinances be read at three (3) successive meeting be suspended, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
